

APAMALL Requirements for Offering International Honorary Doctoral Degrees

This document was endorsed on September 21, 2013 and revised on May 8, 2015 by the APAMALL Executive Committee.

The Asia Pacific Association of Multimedia Assisted Language Learning (APAMALL) offers honorary doctoral degrees to individuals with extraordinary achievements or to those who make generous contributions and complete substantial amounts of public service. Anyone who has substantially contributed to the growth of APAMALL can be also a candidate for such a degree.

Significance

An APAMALL honorary doctoral degree allows accomplished individuals to receive recognition for their successes. Those who receive an APAMALL honorary doctoral degree can use the title associated with the degree just the same as those who complete a doctoral program at a university.

Function

The APAMALL honorary doctoral degree provides accomplished, clearly talented and knowledgeable people with recognition for their superior accomplishments in their professions or public services.

Credentials

APAMALL reserves honorary doctorates for those people who demonstrate superior professional achievements and those who contribute substantially to worthy causes either through academic achievements, volunteer services or monetary donations. Proof of these requirements may be submitted through resumes and autobiographical sketches.

Types

The APAMALL may give one of several different types of honorary doctoral degrees. The possibilities include Doctor of Literature, Doctor of Public Benefits, Doctor of Humanities, Doctor of Foreign Language Teaching, and other fields that APAMALL decides on.

Donation

Donation helps to support APAMALL in offering global academic services. An honorary degree entails a donation for promoting academic achievements through awarding scholarships and research grants, and offering assistance with academic buildings.
